10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	Section 1. Section 61-9-409, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"61-9-409. Seatbelts required in new vehicles <u> use</u>
13	of safety belts required comparative negligence other
14	traffic offense necessary for citation. (1) It is unlawful
15	for any person to buy, sell, lease, trade, or transfer from
16	or to Montana residents at retail an automobile which is
17	manufactured or assembled commencing with the 1966 models
18	unless such vehicle is equipped with safety belts installed
19	for use in the left front and right front seats thereof, and
20	no such vehicle shall be operated in this state unless such
21	belts remain installed and are worn by the driver and any
22	right front seat passenger.
23	(2) Failure of the driver or any right front seat
24	passenger to wear a safety belt as required in subsection
25	(1) is negligence per se, and the comparative negligence

- 2 (3) No law enforcement officer may cite any person for
- 3 failure to wear a safety belt as required in subsection (1)
- 4 unless the officer has first halted the motor vehicle
- 5 involved with probable cause that a violation of another
