1                    SENATE BILL NO. 63  
2    INTRODUCED BY HALLIGAN  
3  
4    A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT AN  
5    AGREEMENT REQUIRING ARBITRATION IS VALID; AMENDING SECTION  
6    28-2-708, MCA."  
7  
8    BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
9            Section 1. Section 28-2-708, MCA, is amended to read:  
10           "28-2-708. Restraints upon legal proceedings void.  
11    Every stipulation or condition in a contract by which any  
12    party thereto is restricted from enforcing his rights under  
13    the contract by the usual proceedings in the ordinary  
14    tribunals or which limits the time within which he may thus  
15    enforce his rights is void. This section does not affect  
16    the validity of an agreement to submit to arbitration."  
17           NEW SECTION. Section 2. Coordination instruction. If  
18    [LC 185], including the section of that bill that amends  
19    28-2-708 to provide that 28-2-708 does not affect the  
20    validity of an agreement enforceable under the Uniform  
21    Arbitration Act, is passed and approved, section 1 of this  
22    act, amending 28-2-708, is void.
