as provided in 7-4-2812; and the county auditor in all
counties wherein such office is authorized, for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 1981, is computed by adding the
annual base salary of:

The cost-of-living increment for 9 10 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1983, and for each subsequent fiscal year shall be added to all cost-of-living 11 increments granted for previous years. 12
