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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT

OF THE MAXIMUM INCENTIVE AWARD PERMITTED UNDER THE STATEWIDE

THE EMPLOYEE INCENTIVE AWARD PROGRAM FROM \$500 TO \$1,500;

REMOVING THE PROVISION TERMINATING THE PROGRAM; AMENDING

SECTION 2-18-1106, MCA; REPEALING SECTION 7, CHAPTER 552,

LAWS OF 1981, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 1, CHAPTER 61, LAWS OF

1983; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-18-1106, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-18-1106. Agency head to grant award -- amount and source of award. (1) After an agency implements an employee's suggestion or invention and the monetary savings to the state is estimated, an agency head, upon written application to and approval from the department and the incentive awards advisory council, may grant an incentive award to an employee whose proposal meets the requirements enumerated in 2-18-1105.

(2) The incentive award may not be more than 10% of the savings resulting from implementing the employee's proposal for 1 year up to a maximum of \$500 \$1,500. Larger

- awards may be proposed and submitted to the legislature for
 consideration.
- 3 (3) The agency head shall pay the employee from the 4 agency's budget in a single, lump-sum award. This award is 5 in addition to the recipient's regular compensation."
- 6 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Repealer. Section 7, Chapter 7 552, Laws of 1981, as amended by section 1, Chapter 61, Laws of 1983, is repealed.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 3. Effective date. This act is 10 effective July 1, 1985.
