 deposited in the other special revenue funds for the use of
 the committee as provided in this part.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 154 proposes to change the assessment to fund the Pork Research and Marketing committee from a flat .20¢ per head on swine sold to a percentage, .3%, of the amount for which swine are sold by producers to purchasers. This bill also changes from 50% to, a percentage determined by the Pork Committee, the amount of assessment that is paid to the National Pork Producers Council.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. 275,000 hogs are sold annually.
- 2. Average market price per head is \$100.00.
- 3. The percentage allocation paid to the National Pork Council will have no fiscal impact to Montana.
