(1) require pupils in the commercial, industrial arts, music, domestic science, scientific, or agricultural courses to pay reasonable fees to cover the actual cost of breakage and of excessive supplies used; and
(2) charge pupils a reasonable fee for any course or activity not reasonably related to a recognized academic and educational goal of the district or any course or activity held outside normal school functions."
