- (3) "Enlarged district" is the elementary or high school district resulting from the consolidation or annexation of two or more component districts.



- (4) "General bonus payment" shall be \$300 per eligible pupil per year for a period of 3 years and will be deposited in the enlarged district's general fund. Such payment shall be made from the state school equalization aid account.
- (5) "Transportation bonus payment" will be the provision of 66 2/3% state financing of the on-schedule transportation amount as provided by the transportation provisions of the school laws. When an eligible pupil is 10 entitled to transportation, the enlarged district shall be entitled to the transportation bonus payment for such 11 12 eligible pupil for a period of 3 years. Such payment shall 13 be made from the state transportation aid account. When the eligible pupil rides a bus providing transportation for 14 15 ineligible pupils, the 66 2/3% state financing of the 16 on-schedule amount for this payment shall be prorated to 17 provide such financing for the eligible pupil."
