A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PLACE ALL PASSENGER TRAMWAY REGISTRATION FEES AND ASSESSMENTS ON THE GROSS RECEIPTS OF PASSENGER TRAMWAYS IN THE STATE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND; AMENDING SECTIONS 23-2-714 AND 23-2-715, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-2-714, MCA, is amended to read:

"23-2-714. Fees. (1) The application for registration
or supplemental application shall be accompanied by such
annual fees as the department may fix from year to year, not

to exceed the following annual fees:

17 (a) passenger tramways described in subsections (5)(e)
18 and (5)(f) of 23-2-702, \$25 each;

(b) passenger tramways described in subsections (5)(c)
and (5)(d) of 23-2-702, \$50 each;

21 (c) passenger tramways described in subsections (5)(a)
22 and (5)(b) of 23-2-702, \$100 each.

23 (2) All fees collected by the department shall be
