 5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PLACE ALL PASSENGER
 6 TRAMWAY REGISTRATION FEES AND ASSESSMENTS ON THE GROSS
 7 RECEIPTS OF PASSENGER TRAMWAYS IN THE STATE SPECIAL REVENUE
 8 FUND; AMENDING SECTIONS 23-2-714 AND 23-2-715, MCA; AND
 9 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 23-2-714, MCA, is amended to read:
 13 "23-2-714. Fees. (1) The application for registration
 14 or supplemental application shall be accompanied by such
 15 annual fees as the department may fix from year to year, not
 16 to exceed the following annual fees:

17 (a) passenger tramways described in subsections (5)(e)
 18 and (5)(f) of 23-2-702, \$25 each;

19 (b) passenger tramways described in subsections (5)(c)
 20 and (5)(d) of 23-2-702, \$50 each;

21 (c) passenger tramways described in subsections (5)(a)
 22 and (5)(b) of 23-2-702, \$100 each.

23 (2) All fees collected by the department shall be
 24 deposited in the general state special revenue fund. ~~It is~~
 25 ~~the legislature's intent that such fees and assessments~~

1 ~~generate sufficient revenue for a general fund appropriation~~
 2 ~~for contracted inspection services."~~

3 Section 2. Section 23-2-715, MCA, is amended to read:
 4 "23-2-715. Assessment on passenger tramway receipts.

5 (1) The department of administration is hereby authorized to
 6 impose an assessment of 1/4 of 1% on the gross receipts of
 7 all passenger tramways operated in the state of Montana. A
 8 minimum of \$100 shall be collected annually from the owner
 9 of a passenger tramway facility. The assessment shall be
 10 calculated upon gross receipts received during the period
 11 July 1 of any year to July 1 of the following year. The
 12 assessments shall be collected by the department of revenue
 13 and remitted to the general state special revenue fund by
 14 December 31 of each year.

15 (2) All proceeds of the gross receipts assessment and
 16 the fees collected under 23-2-714 shall be used only to
 17 support the duties of the department set forth in this
 18 part."

19 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Extension of authority. Any
 20 existing authority of the department of administration to
 21 make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is
 22 extended to the provisions of this act.

23 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. This act is
 24 effective July 1, 1985.
