 13 Section 1. Section 2-17-501, MCA, is amended to read:
 14 "2-17-501. Responsibilities of director of department
 15 of administration for data processing. (1) Except as
 16 provided in subsection (2), the director of the department
 17 of administration shall:
 18 (a) establish policies and a statewide plan, in
 19 cooperation with state agencies, for the operation and
 20 development of data processing for state government;
 21 (b) review and approve agency specifications and
 22 procurement methods for the acquisition of data processing
 23 equipment, ~~excluding specifications and methods relating to~~

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE MONTANA UNIVERSITY SYSTEM FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO DATA PROCESSING UNLESS THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM'S PROPOSED DATA PROCESSING ACTIVITY IMPACTS THE STATE CENTRAL COMPUTER AND DATA PROCESSING EQUIPMENT POOL; AMENDING SECTION 2-17-501, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-17-501, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-17-501. Responsibilities of director of department of administration for data processing. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the director of the department of administration shall:

(a) establish policies and a statewide plan, in cooperation with state agencies, for the operation and development of data processing for state government;

(b) review and approve agency specifications and procurement methods for the acquisition of data processing equipment, ~~excluding specifications and methods relating to instruction and research in the university system,~~ to insure network compatibility and conformity with the statewide data

processing plan;

(c) review and approve all contracts for private sector data processing services to insure conformance with the statewide data processing plan; and

(d) operate and maintain a central computer center and a data processing equipment pool for the use of all state agencies and political subdivisions.

(2) (a) The responsibilities of the director under this section subsection (1) do not apply to the office of the superintendent of public instruction, and that office is exempt from the requirements of this section subsection (1).

(b) The responsibilities of the director under subsection (1)(b) do not apply to the Montana university system, and the university system is exempt from the requirements of subsection (1)(b) unless a proposed university system activity related to data processing impacts the operation of the central computer center and data processing equipment pool. If the university system determines that such an impact may occur, the system shall notify the director, and the proposed activity is subject to the requirements of subsection (1)(b)."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. This act is effective July 1, 1985.
