1	sheriff or undersheriff is entitled to receive a longevity
2	payment amounting to 1% a percentage of the minimum base
3	annual salary for each year of service with the department.
4	This payment shall be made in equal monthly installments.
5	(2) (a) The regular salary of a deputy sheriff or

13	(2) (a) The sheriff shall fix the compensation of the
14	deputy sheriff based upon a percentage of the salary of that
15	sheriff according to the following schedule:

17	Below 15,000 85% to 90%
18	15,000 to 29,999 76% to 90%
19	30,000 to 74,999 74% to 90%
20	75,000 and over 72% to 90%
21	(b) The sheriff shall adjust the compensation of the
