A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A LAPSED OCCUPATIONAL OR PROFESSIONAL LICENSE WHICH IS NOT RENEWED WITHIN 3 YEARS OF THE MOST RECENT RENEWAL DATE AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATES AND MAY NOT BE RENEWED."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Nonrenewal of license for three years -- termination. Unless otherwise provided by law, a lapsed occupational or professional license that is not renewed within 3 years of the most recent renewal date automatically terminates. The terminated license may not be reinstated, and a new original license must be obtained.
