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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Grounds for disciplinary action as grounds for license denial -- conditions to new licenses. (1) Unless otherwise provided by law, grounds for disciplinary action by a board allocated to the department of commerce against a holder of an occupational or professional license are MAY BE, UNDER APPROPRIATE CIRCUMSTANCES, grounds for EITHER ISSUANCE OF A PROBATIONARY LICENSE FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 1 YEAR OR denial of a license to an applicant.
