9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 16-4-109, MCA, is amended to read: "16-4-109. Publicly owned colf---course athletic 11 facility beer and wine license. (1) Upon application, the 12 department of revenue shall issue a retail beer and wine 13 license, to be known as a publicly owned golf--course 14 athletic facility beer and wine license, for use at a 15 publicly owned golf-course athletic facility, including but 16 not limited to a baseball park, an arena, a stadium, or a 17 playing field. 18

19 (2) The application must be made by the local
20 government owning and operating the public gelf-course
21 <u>athletic facility</u>. The local government may lease the
22 license for use at the gelf-course <u>athletic facility</u> to an
23 individual or entity approved by the department.

24 (3) A publicly owned golf--course athletic facility
25 beer and wine license and all retail beer and wine sales




1 thereunder are subject to all statutes and rules governing a
2 retail beer license with a wine license amendment.

3 (4) The department of revenue shall issue a publicly 4 owned golf-course <u>athletic facility</u> beer and wine license to 5 a qualified applicant regardless of the number of beer and 6 wine licenses already issued within the beer and wine 7 license quota area in which the golf--course <u>athletic</u> 8 <u>facility</u> is situated. A license issued pursuant to this 9 section is nontransferable."

10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Effective date. This act is 11 effective on passage and approval.

In compliance with a written request received February 4, 19 85, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for S.B. 304 pursuant to Title 5, Chapter 4, Part 2 of the Montana Code Annotated (MCA). Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act making all publicly owned athletic facilities eligible for a beer and wine license outside the quota system; amending section 16-4-109, MCA; and providing an immediate effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

The proposed legislation should have a minimal fiscal impact on the state general fund. License revenue would be increased by \$400 for each publicly owned athletic facility license. Enforcement costs may be increased because of additional licenses being issued.
