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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
13	Section 1. Section 69-3-103, MCA, is amended to read:
14	"69-3-103. General powers and rulemaking authority of
15	commission. (1) In addition to the modes of procedure
16	hereinafter prescribed in particular cases and classes of
17	cases, said commission shall have power to prescribe rules
18	of procedure and to do all things necessary and convenient
19	in the exercise of the powers conferred by this chapter upon
20	the commission; provided that nothing in this chapter shall
21	be construed as vesting judicial powers on said commission
22	or as denying to any person, firm, association, corporation,
23	municipality, county, town, or village the right to test in

court of competent jurisdiction the legality or 24 а reasonableness of any fixed order made by the commission in 25

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the exercise of its duties or powers. 1 2 (2) The commission shall have the power to: 3 (a) adopt reasonable and proper rules relative to all inspections, tests, audits, and investigations; 4 5 (b) adopt and publish reasonable and proper rules to 6 govern its proceedings; and 7 (c) regulate the mode and manner of all investigations and hearings of public utilities and other parties before 8 9 it. 10 (3) (a) The commission may, upon its own motion or upon the request of a proper party, issue an order to show 11 12 cause to prevent a public utility from executing a proposed 13 action. Through the issuance of the order to show cause, the 14 commission may prevent a public utility from taking action 15 that: 16 (i) will harm or threatens to harm the public health, welfare, and safety; 17 18 (ii) may be unlawful under this chapter; 19 (iii) will affect the ability of the commission to 20 ensure reasonable rates; or 21 (iv) involves any combination of subsections (3)(a)(i) 22 through (3)(a)(iii). 23 (b) The order to show cause must describe the proposed action of the public utility, provide the basis of the 24 25 commission's contention that the action at issue should be INTRODUCED BILL

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prevented, and provide the public utility with notice and an
 opportunity to show cause before the commission why its
 proposed action should not be prevented.

4 (c) Following the public utility's opportunity to show 5 cause, the commission shall determine whether the action at 6 issue should be permanently prevented by the commission. If 7 the commission cannot make that determination based on 8 evidence presented at the show cause hearing, the commission 9 shall initiate an appropriate commission proceeding to investigate the proposed action and its effects, in which 10 case the preventive order remains in effect pending such 11 12 proceeding.

(d) If the public utility's proposed action is 13 imminent, the commission may issue a temporary order to show 14 cause, without notice, to immediately prevent the public 15 16 utility from acting. The public utility must be provided an 17 opportunity to show cause before the commission within 10 18 days of the issuance of the temporary order. Following the 19 opportunity to show cause, the commission shall make the required determination pursuant to subsection (3)(c)." 20

21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
22 existing authority of the public service commission to make
23 rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is
24 extended to the provisions of this act.

25 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is

effective on passage and approval.

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
