4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOCATING \$750,000 IN
 5 FISCAL YEAR 1985 AND \$450,000 IN FISCAL YEAR 1986 OF COAL
 6 BOARD FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF
 7 LAWS RELATING TO DRUGS AND STOLEN GOODS; AND PROVIDING AN
 8 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Allocation of local impact funds for drug
 12 law enforcement. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of
 13 90-6-205 through 90-6-207 and 90-6-209, the coal board shall
 14 allocate to the department of justice from the funds
 15 authorized in 90-6-205 for grants and loans:

- 16 (a) \$750,000 in fiscal year 1985; and
- 17 (b) \$450,000 in fiscal year 1986.

18 (2) The department of justice shall expend the money
 19 allocated in subsection (1) for statewide enforcement of the
 20 provisions of 45-6-301 through 45-6-304 and Title 45,
 21 chapters 9 and 10, and investigation of violations of those
 22 provisions.

23 Section 2. Retention of unexpended balance.
 24 Notwithstanding the provisions of 17-7-304, any portion of
 25 the allocations in section 1 unexpended at the end of the

1 fiscal year in which allocated is available during the next
 2 and succeeding fiscal years to the department of justice for
 3 the purposes provided in section 1.

4 Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on
 5 passage and approval.
