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9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 80-4-710, MCA, is amended to read: 10 "80-4-710. Protein test available---on---all---grain 11 delivered--to--grain--warehouses -- manner-of-making-test---12 procedure -- fee -- penalty. (1) Each warehouseman shall 13 take samples from each load of grain delivered to his 14 warehouse and preserve the sample in a moistureproof 15 container with the owner's name on it. A 1-pint portion of 16 the composite sample may must be submitted to the 17 department, except when an official test is waived under 18 subsection (2), and the balance must be held in the owner's 19 20 container.

The department's certificate of 6 the test is final and binding upon both parties in 7 establishing the basis of the price paid by the 8 warehouseman.
