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24 25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 80-8-109, MCA, is amended to read:
"80-8-109. Educational programs. (1) The department
shall develop and conduct appropriate educational programs.
The educational programs shall inform those individuals
dealing in and applying pesticides as to correct methods of
formulating, applying, storing, disposing of, handling, and
transporting pesticides.

- (2) In developing and administering such programs, the department may consult other state and federal agencies and private industry, as well as such other persons it considers necessary, and may charge a fee for the programs commensurate with their administration costs. The fee may not include the salary or travel expenses of any employee of the state or a unit of the Montana university system.
- (3) All fees collected in--any--fiscal--year--and--not expended--within--that--fiscal--year--must--be--placed-in-an
