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4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CLARIFYING THAT FEES  
 5 COLLECTED FOR PESTICIDE EDUCATION PROGRAMS MUST BE EXPENDED  
 6 FOR SUCH PURPOSES; AMENDING SECTION 80-8-109, MCA; AND  
 7 PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 80-8-109, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "80-8-109. Educational programs. (1) The department  
 12 shall develop and conduct appropriate educational programs.  
 13 The educational programs shall inform those individuals  
 14 dealing in and applying pesticides as to correct methods of  
 15 formulating, applying, storing, disposing of, handling, and  
 16 transporting pesticides.

17 (2) In developing and administering such programs, the  
 18 department may consult other state and federal agencies and  
 19 private industry, as well as such other persons it considers  
 20 necessary, and may charge a fee for the programs  
 21 commensurate with their administration costs. The fee may  
 22 not include the salary or travel expenses of any employee of  
 23 the state or a unit of the Montana university system.

24 (3) All fees collected ~~in any fiscal year and not~~  
 25 ~~expended within that fiscal year must be placed in an~~

1 ~~educational and manuals account of the state special revenue~~  
 2 ~~fund for future use for that purpose pursuant to this~~  
 3 ~~section must be deposited in the state treasury to the~~  
 4 ~~credit of the state special revenue fund and must be spent~~  
 5 ~~for the purposes set forth in this section."~~

6 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any  
 7 existing authority of the department of agriculture to make  
 8 rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is  
 9 extended to the provisions of this act.

10 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is  
 11 effective on passage and approval.
