BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
Section 1. Section 19-5-301, MCA, is amended to read:  
"19-5-301. Membership. (1) A judge or justice who was a member of the PERS prior to ~~March 27, 1967~~ December 31, 1984, may elect to remain under that system by notifying the public employees' retirement board in writing of the election on or before October 1, 1967 1985.

Description of Proposed Legislation

Senate Bill No. 384 permits a district judge or supreme court justice who was a member of the PERS before 12-31-84 to remain a member of PERS rather than join the Judges' Retirement System.

Fiscal Impact

This bill has no effect on the funding requirements of either the PERS or the Judges' Retirement System.
