11 "87-2-803. Disabled persons. (1) Disabled persons are
 12 entitled to fish and to hunt game birds with only a
 13 conservation license if they are residents of Montana not
 14 residing in an institution and are certified as disabled as
 15 prescribed by departmental rule.

16 (2) A resident of Montana who is certified as disabled
 17 by the department and who is not residing in an institution
 18 may purchase regular resident deer and elk licenses at
 19 one-half the fee paid by a resident who is 15 years old or
 20 older and who is under 62 years of age.

21 (3) Such disabled persons shall carry a permit on a
 22 form prescribed by the department.

23 (4) A resident of Montana who is certified as disabled
 24 by the department and who applies for a Class A-1, A-3, A-4,
 25 A-5, or A-6 license may receive a certification on his

1 permit issued pursuant to subsection (3) that allows another
 2 person with the same class of license to shoot and kill in
 3 the presence of the licensee any game permitted by the
 4 disabled person's license. The certification on the disabled
 5 person's permit must include the name of the person or
 6 persons who will accompany the disabled person to make the
 7 kill of any permitted game."

 9 existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and
 10 parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this
 11 act is extended to the provisions of this act.
