4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A BOARD OF

 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Licensing of horse riding stables. (1) The
 10 board of county commissioners may license and regulate horse
 11 riding stables.

12 (2) For purposes of this section, "horse riding
 13 stable" means an enterprise in which one or more horses are
 14 let for hire to be ridden or driven, either with or without
 15 the furnishing of riding or driving instruction. The board
 16 may further define "horse riding stable".

17 (3) The board may require as a condition of receiving
 18 a horse riding stable license that the applicant exhibit
 19 proof of liability insurance to cover his horse riding
 20 stable enterprise. The board may not require insurance in
 21 excess of \$10,000 for property damage, \$100,000 for personal
 22 injury to one person, and \$300,000 for personal injury to
 23 more than one person.

24 (4) The board may charge a fee, not to exceed \$50, for
 25 issuance of the license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Licensing of horse riding stables. (1) The
