9 Section 1. Licensing of horse riding stables. (1) The 10 board of county commissioners may license and regulate horse 11 riding stables.

- (2) For purposes of this section, "horse riding stable" means an enterprise in which one or more horses are let for hire to be ridden or driven, either with or without the furnishing of riding or driving instruction. The board may further define "horse riding stable".
- (3) The board may require as a condition of receiving a horse riding stable license that the applicant exhibit proof of liability insurance to cover his horse riding stable enterprise. The board may not require insurance in excess of \$10,000 for property damage, \$100,000 for personal injury to one person, and \$300,000 for personal injury to more than one person.
