Manning, Hirsch, Blaylock, Regan, Eck, Neuman, Christiaens, B. Brown, Galt, H. Hammond, Goodover, Thayer, Farrell, Severson, Himsl, Keating, Story, Anderson, and Shaw added as sponsors.
January 10, 1985	Committee recommend bill do pass as amended. Report adopted.
January 11, 1985	Bill printed and placed on members' desks.
January 12, 1985	Second reading, do pass.
January 14, 1985	Considered correctly engrossed.
January 15, 1985	Third reading, passed. Ayes, 49; Noes, 0. Transmitted to House.

9 WHEREAS, The Legislature recognizes that participation
10 in sports and athletic competition is a most beneficial
11 activity for developmentally disabled youth and adults; and

12 WHEREAS, the Montana Special Olympics program has been
13 established to give each developmentally disabled person a
14 chance to develop his skills, to experience success, and to
15 grow both physically and mentally through an organized
16 program of physical fitness and sports; and

17 WHEREAS, the State of Montana is participating in the
18 Special Olympics and making the program's benefits available
19 to developmentally disabled youth and adults of this state.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE
22 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

23 That the Legislature hereby expresses its enthusiastic
24 support of the Montana Special Olympics program and
25 recognizes May 12 through May 18, 1985, and May 14 through

1 May 17, 1986, as "Montana Special Olympics Week".

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Montana citizens are
3 encouraged to participate in and to give their support to
4 this unique and important program which gives each
5 developmentally disabled youth and adult his best chance to
6 share in the experiences of athletic competition which he
7 would otherwise be denied.
