A RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA *Stett*

INSTRUCTING ARCHITECTS TO PROCEED WITH CAPITOL RENOVATION *Wade*
PLANS PREVIOUSLY APPROVED. *Cap*

WHEREAS, for the past several sessions, controversy has *Stett*
surrounded the question of moving the Senate; and *Wade*

WHEREAS, the issue was, or should have been, *Cap*
conclusively settled with the enactment of section 2-17-109, *Stett*
MCA, which says, "The department of administration . . .
shall keep and maintain the senate chambers in its present
location"; and

WHEREAS, a reversal of our earlier decisions at this
time would cause additional expense and delay in the process
of renovating the Capitol; and

WHEREAS, plans based on past decisions are now ready to
be submitted for preparation of bids; and

WHEREAS, the Capitol Building and Planning Committee,
on October 24, 1984, instructed the architects to proceed
for a bid opening to be held January 15, 1985.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
MONTANA:

1 That the Senate instructs the architects to proceed
2 immediately to submit plans for bid based on plans approved
3 October 24, 1984.
