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NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date -- contingent retroactive effect -- termination. (1) This act is effective on passage and approval and retreated to light vehicles registered on or after July 1, 1985. If this act is approved after June 30, 1985, it applies retroactively within the meaning of 1-2-109 to light vehicles registered on or after July 1, 1985.

9 (2) This act terminates July 1, 1987. This termination 10 does not affect the reinsertion of \$1-3-533(2) as it read on 11 January 1, 1985.

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill reinstates the inflator clause that was repealed by SB 142 of the 1985 regular session to provide for automatic inflation of vehicle fees.

- 1. Number of registered vehicles remains constant at the 1984 level: 649,466.
