March 26, 1986	Committee recommend bill be concurring in. Report adopted. Second reading, concurred in. Third reading, concurred in. Ayes, 48; Noes, 0. Returned to House.

March 27, 1986	Sent to enrolling. Reported correctly enrolled.

4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A
5 SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE ELECTION OF NEW OFFICIALS TO
6 IMPLEMENT A CHANGE IN THE FORM OF A LOCAL GOVERNMENT MAY BE
7 HELD ON A REGULARLY SCHEDULED PRIMARY OR GENERAL ELECTION
8 DATE; AMENDING SECTION 7-3-160, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
9 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 7-3-160, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "7-3-160. Election of new officials. (1) Within 20
14 days after an election at which the new plan of government
15 is approved by the electors, the governing body of the local
16 government shall meet and order a special primary and
17 general election for the purpose of electing the officials
18 required by the new form of government. The elections for
19 officials may be held in conjunction with any other
20 election.

21 (2) The order shall specify:

22 (a) a date for the primary election not more than 120
23 days or less than 75 days after the to be held no later than
24 the next regularly scheduled city or county primary
25 election; approving the new form and

1 (b) a date for the general election 75-days-after--the
2 primary to be held no later than the next regularly
3 scheduled city or county general election following the
4 primary election date established under subsection (2)(a)."
5 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. This act is
6 effective on passage and approval.
