WHEREAS, a joint resolution has been introduced to  
establish a revenue estimation subcommittee in each house;  
and

WHEREAS, that resolution specifies a subcommittee of  
four members appointed by the chairman of the Committee on  
Taxation; and

WHEREAS, the related House Rule should be consistent  
with the Joint Rule, if adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

That House Rule H3-5 is amended as follows:

"H3-5. By the first legislative day there shall be  
appointed a revenue subcommittee of the Taxation Committee  
made up of four members of the Taxation Committee. The  
subcommittee shall be appointed in--the--same--manner--as  
members--of--standing--committees--as--provided--in--H3-2 by the

chairman of the Taxation Committee. The first named member  
of the subcommittee is the chairman and in his absence the  
next named member, and so on. The revenue subcommittee shall  
review state revenue and recommend estimated revenue levels  
for the next biennium to the Taxation-Committee House by the  
18th legislative day."
