In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB003, as originally introduced.

Description of Proposed Legislation:

To remove the limitation on the amount of notes that the Board of Examiners may issue in anticipation of revenue.

Assumptions:

- 1. TRAN's issue size determined by IRS regulations TRAN's issue size in FY87 would be \$70,000,000.
- 2. Arbitrage spread would be 2.5% calculated as the difference of the reinvestment rate of 7.0% and the note rate of 4.5%.
- 3. The note proceeds would be invested approximately 11/12 of the time; 1/12 of the time note proceeds would be used to cover general fund deficits.
- 4. July 1 issue date allowing the TRAN's issue to be outstanding approximately one year.
- 5. No effect next biennium because pending federal legislation will require arbitrage rebate to federal government.
