4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO SUBMIT TO THE
5	QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA THE REPEAL OF ARTICLE IX
6	SECTION 5, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION WHICH PROVIDES FOR
7	THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COAL SEVERANCE TAX TRUST FUND, THE

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
13	Section 1. Repealer. Article IX, section 5, of The
14	Constitution of the State of Montana is repealed.
15	Section 2. Effective date. If approved by the
16	electorate, this repeal is effective July 1, 1987.
17	Section 3. Submission to electorate. This amendment
18	shall be submitted to the electors of Montana at the general
19	election held in November 1986 by printing on the ballot the
20	full title of this act and the following:
21	FOR removing from the constitution the section that
22	establishes a coal severance tax trust fund and
23	restricts legislative appropriation of the trust
24	principal.
25	AGAINST removing from the constitution the section

1	that establishes a coal severance tax trust fund and
2	restricts legislative appropriation of the trust
3	principal.
4	Section 4. Exemption from application of ballot-issue
5	statute. For the purposes of this act, the transmittal to
6	the attorney general required of the secretary of state by
7	13-27-310(2) must be made no later than 100 days before the
8	November 1986 election.
9	Section 5. Two-thirds vote. Since this act proposes an
10	amendment to the Montana Constitution, it must be adopted by
11	a two-thirds vote of all members, whether one or more
12	bodies.
13	Section 6. Effective date. This act is effective on
14	passage and approval.
