4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT DESIGNATING THE
5 BIRTHDAY OF MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. AS A STATE HOLIDAY; AND
6 AMENDING SECTIONS 1-1-216 AND 20-1-305, MCA."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
9 Section 1. Section 1-1-216, MCA, is amended to read:
10 "1-1-216. Legal holidays and business days. (1) The
11 following are legal holidays in the state of Montana:
12 (a) Each Sunday;
13 (b) New Year's Day, January 1;
14 (c) Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday, the third
15 Monday in January;
16 (e)(d) Lincoln's Birthday, February 12;
17 (d)(e) Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in
18 February;
19 (e)(f) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
20 (f)(g) Independence Day, July 4;
21 (g)(h) Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
22 (h)(i) Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;
23 (i)(j) Veterans' Day, November 11;
24 (j)(k) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in
25 November;

1 (k)(l) Christmas Day, December 25;
2 (i)(m) State general election day.
3 (2) If any of the above-enumerated holidays (except
4 Sunday) fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a
5 holiday. All other days are business days."
6 Section 2. Section 20-1-305, MCA, is amended to read:
7 "20-1-305. School holidays. (1) Pupil instruction and
8 pupil-instruction-related days shall not be conducted on the
9 following holidays:
10 (a) New Year's Day (January 1);
11 (b) Martin Luther King Jr.'s Birthday (third Monday in
12 January);
13 (b)(c) Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
14 (e)(d) Independence Day (July 4);
15 (d)(e) Labor Day (first Monday in September);
16 (e)(f) Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
17 (f)(g) Christmas Day (December 25);
18 (g)(h) State and national election days when the
19 school building is used as a polling place and the conduct
20 of school would interfere with the election process at the
21 polling place.
22 (2) When these holidays fall on Saturday or Sunday,
23 the preceding Friday or the succeeding Monday shall not be a
24 school holiday."
