HOUSE BILL NO. 18 BRADIEY

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TWO presidential electors be chosen from the state at large and ONE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR BE CHOSEN FROM EACH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT; AMENDING SECTIONS 13-25-101, 13-25-102, AND 13-25-104, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY TEE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 13-25-101, MCA, is amended to read:
"13-25-101. Nomination of electors -- ballot. (1) Each political party qualified under 13-10-601 shall nominate one presidential elector from each congressional district and two electors at large for this state and file certificates of nomination for these candidates with the secretary of state no later than 75 days before the general election, in the manner and number provided by law.
(2) The secretary of state shall certify to the election administrator the names of the candidates for president and vice president of the several political parties, which shall be printed on the ballot.
(3) The names of candidates for electors of president and vice president may not be printed upon the ballot."

Section 2. Section 13-25-102, MCA, is amended to read:
"13-25-102. Election of electors. (1) On the Tuesday next after the first Monday of November in the year in which a president of the United states is to be elected, there shall be elected as many electors for president and vice president of the United States as are allocated to this state.
(2) The votes cast for candidates for president and vice president of each political party in each congressional district and for the state at large shall be counted for the candidates for presidential electors of the political party whose names have been filed with the secretary of state."

Section 3. Section 13-25-104, MCA, is amended to read:
"13-25-104. Meeting and voting of electors. (1) The electors shall meet in Helena at 2 p.m. on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December following their election.
(2) The electors shall vote by separate ballots for one person for president and one for vice president of the United States.
