5 HEADGEAR FOR ALL MOTORCYCLE OR QUADRICYCLE RIDERS; AND
6 AMENDING SECTIONS 61-9-417 AND 61-9-518, MCA."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 61-9-417, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "61-9-417. Headgear required for minor motorcycle or
11 quadricycle riders. An The operator and passenger under--18
12 years--of-age of any motorcycle or quadricycle operated upon
13 the streets or highways of this state shall wear protective
14 headgear upon the head. The headgear shall meet standards
15 established by the department of justice."

16 Section 2. Section 61-9-518, MCA, is amended to read:

17 "61-9-518. Violation of motorcycle or quadricycle
18 requirements -- penalty. {1} A person convicted of the
19 violation of 61-9-417 ~~shall-be-fined-\$5-~~

20 ~~{2}--A-person-convicted-of-the-violation-of or~~ 61-9-418
21 shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 or more
22 than \$100 or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days or by
23 both such fine and imprisonment for the first such
24 conviction. For a second conviction within 1 year
25 thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not

1 less than \$25 or more than \$200 or by imprisonment for not
2 more than 20 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
3 Upon a third or subsequent conviction within 1 year after
4 the first conviction, such person shall be punished by a
5 fine of not less than \$50 or more than \$500 or by
6 imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both such fine
7 and imprisonment."
