 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 1-1-216, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "1-1-216. Legal holidays and business days. (1) The
 11 following are legal holidays in the state of Montana:

- 12 (a) Each Sunday;
- 13 (b) New Year's Day, January 1;
- 14 (c) Heritage Day, January 15;
- 15 ~~(d)~~ Lincoln's Birthday, February 12;
- 16 ~~(e)~~ Washington's Birthday, the third Monday in
 17 February;
- 18 ~~(f)~~ Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;
- 19 ~~(g)~~ Independence Day, July 4;
- 20 ~~(h)~~ Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
- 21 ~~(i)~~ ~~Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;~~
- 22 (i) Veterans' Day, November 11;
- 23 (j) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
- 24 (k) Christmas Day, December 25;
- 25 (l) State general election day.

1 (2) If any of the above-enumerated holidays (except
 2 Sunday) fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a
 3 holiday. All other days are business days."
