17	February;
18	<pre>(e)(f) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;</pre>
19	<pre>(f)(g) Independence Day, July 4;</pre>
20	(g)(h) Labor Day, the first Monday in September;
21	(h)Columbus-Day;-the-second-Monday-in-October;
22	(i) Veterans' Day, November 11;
23	(j) Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;
24	(k) Christmas Day, December 25;
25	(1) State general election day.

1 (2) If any of the above-enumerated holidays (except 2 Sunday) fall upon a Sunday, the Monday following is a 3 holiday. All other days are business days."
