BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Recording to provide notice of lease -extension of lease. (1) Recording of an oil, gas, or mineral lease given on land within the state of Montana in the office of the county clerk and recorder of the county where the land is located is notice to the public of the validity and the continuance of the lease for the term expressed in the lease, but no longer.
(2) If the lease contains a statement of any contingency upon the occurrence of which the term of the lease may be extended, such as during the period of production of oil or gas in paying quantities, the owner of the lease may before the expiration of the lease file with the county clerk and recorder an affidavit setting forth the description of the lease, the fact that the affiant is the owner of the lease, and the facts showing that the
