In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB064, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

A bill for an act entitled: "An act requiring competency training for persons under 18 years of age before purchasing a bow and arrow hunting license; increasing the bow and arrow license fee by \$1; and amending Sections 87-2-105 and 87-2-708, MCA."

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. 5% of the 21,750 bow hunters, or 1,090, persons, are under 18 years of age. All of these hunters would take the bow and arrow hunters training in year one.
- 2. Implementation of this training program would require 0.1 FTE.
- 3. 2.6% of all hunters take hunter education classes each year. This same percentage of all bow and arrow hunters would take bow and arrow hunter education classes each year starting with year 2. 565 bow and arrow hunters would take the class in year 2.
- 4. It currently costs \$18.40 per student for hunter education classes. Bow hunter education classes would also cost \$18.40 per student.
