 6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CLARIFY LIABILITY OF
 7 JUNK VEHICLE OWNERS; TO REQUIRE THAT ALL JUNK VEHICLES BE
 8 SHIELDED FROM PUBLIC VIEW; AMENDING SECTION 75-10-542, MCA;
 9 AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Shielding of junk vehicles.
 13 Notwithstanding the provisions of this part, one or more
 14 junk vehicles, regardless of ownership, must be shielded
 15 from public view.

16 Section 2. Section 75-10-542, MCA, is amended to read:
 17 "75-10-542. Penalties. (1) A person who willfully
 18 violates this part, except 75-10-520, or violates a rule of
 19 the department or an order issued pursuant to this part is
 20 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined
 21 not to exceed \$250, imprisoned in the county jail for a term
 22 not to exceed 30 days, or both.

23 (2) A person who violates this part, except 75-10-520,
 24 a rule of the department, or an order issued as provided in
 25 this part shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more

1 than \$50. Each day upon which a violation of this part or a
 2 rule or order occurs is a separate violation."

3 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Codification instruction.
 4 Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of
 5 Title 75, chapter 10, part 5, and the provisions of Title
 6 75, chapter 10, part 5, apply to section 1.

7 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date. This act is
 8 effective on passage and approval.
