6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CHANGE THE INITIAL
 7 APPLICATION FEE FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE WRECKING FACILITY AND TO
 8 CLARIFY THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE AND THE LICENSE FEE FOR
 9 EXISTING FACILITIES NEWLY ACQUIRED; AND AMENDING SECTION
 10 75-10-511, MCA."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Section 75-10-511, MCA, is amended to read:
 14 "75-10-511. Motor vehicle wrecking facility and motor
 15 vehicle graveyard licenses. (1) A person may not conduct,
 16 maintain, or operate a motor vehicle wrecking facility or
 17 motor vehicle graveyard without a license issued by the
 18 department.

19 (2) Application for the license ~~shall~~ must be made on
 20 forms furnished by the department.

21 (3) A person proposing or establishing for the first
 22 time a new motor vehicle wrecking facility on or after
 23 October 1, 1987, shall upon application for an initial
 24 license of the facility pay to the department a
 25 nonrefundable license application fee of \$300.

1 (4) A person seeking a license in his own name
 2 subsequent to a sale or transfer of a previously licensed
 3 motor vehicle wrecking facility shall pay to the department
 4 an initial license application fee of \$50, proratable on a
 5 quarterly basis.

6 ~~(3)~~(5) An annual fee of \$50 ~~shall~~ must be paid to the
 7 department for ~~the--license--or--quarterly--prorated--for--new~~
 8 facilities renewal of a license.

9 ~~(4)~~(6) A motor vehicle graveyard is excluded from
 10 paying the annual license fee but must meet all other
 11 requirements of the part.

12 (5)(7) A license ~~shall~~ must be displayed in a
 13 prominent place in the licensed facility or graveyard.

14 (6)(8) The license expires on December 31 of the year
 15 issued.

16 (7)(9) If a motor vehicle wrecking facility ceases to
 17 do business or is sold, the license ~~shall~~ must be
 18 surrendered to the department. The license is not
 19 transferable."

20 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
 21 existing authority of the department of health and
 22 environmental sciences to make rules on the subject of the
 23 provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this
 24 act.




LONG-RANGE EFFECTS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:
