(2) Not more than 17,000 Class $B-10$ licenses may be sold in any one license year.
(3) An applicant intending to employ a licensed outfitter shall so indicate on the application, and licenses must be apportioned to such applicants in the same ratio that the number of such applicants bears to the total number of applicants.
(4) If the number of valid applications for the class B-10 licenses exceeds 17,000 , the licenses must be awarded by a drawing in accordance with rules established by the department. A list of successful license applicants must be made available to the public."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of fish, wildife, and parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Application. This act does not apply to licenses issued for the 1987 hunting season.
