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4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPORTION THE
5 AUTHORIZED NONRESIDENT BIG GAME COMBINATION LICENSES BETWEEN
6 APPLICANTS INTENDING TO EMPLOY OUTFITTERS AND OTHER
7 APPLICANTS ACCORDING TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF APPLICANTS IN
8 EACH CATEGORY; TO PROVIDE FOR A DRAWING WHEN THE NUMBER OF
9 APPLICANTS EXCEEDS THE NUMBER OF LICENSES AUTHORIZED TO BE
10 ISSUED; AND AMENDING SECTION 87-2-505, MCA."

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Section 87-2-505, MCA, is amended to read:

14 "87-2-505. Class B-10--nonresident big game
15 combination license. (1) Except as otherwise provided in
16 this chapter, a person not a resident, as defined in
17 87-2-102, but who will be 12 years of age or older prior to
18 September 15 of the season for which the license is issued
19 may, upon payment of the fee of \$350 and subject to the
20 limitations prescribed by law and department regulation,
21 apply to the fish and game office, Helena, Montana, to
22 purchase a B-10 nonresident big game combination license
23 which shall entitle the holder to all the privileges of
24 Class B, Class B-1, Class B-7, and black bear licenses, and
25 an elk tag. This license includes the nonresident

1 conservation license as prescribed in 87-2-202.

2 (2) Not more than 17,000 Class B-10 licenses may be
3 sold in any one license year.

4 (3) An applicant intending to employ a licensed
5 outfitter shall so indicate on the application, and licenses
6 must be apportioned to such applicants in the same ratio
7 that the number of such applicants bears to the total number
8 of applicants.

9 (4) If the number of valid applications for the Class
10 B-10 licenses exceeds 17,000, the licenses must be awarded
11 by a drawing in accordance with rules established by the
12 department. A list of successful license applicants must be
13 made available to the public."

14 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
15 existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and
16 parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this
17 act is extended to the provisions of this act.

18 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Application. This act does
19 not apply to licenses issued for the 1987 hunting season.
