Section 53-21-204, MCA, is amended to read: 10 11 "53-21-204. Mental health corporations. (1) Mental 12 health regions shall be established in the state mental 13 health plan and shall conform to the mental health regions as established in the state mental health construction plan 14 15 promulgated by the board of health and environmental sciences under the federal Community Mental Health Centers 16 17 Act. (2) The mental health regions shall establish 18 themselves under Title 35, chapter 2. Upon incorporation, a 19 20 mental health region may enter into contracts with the

21 department in order to carry out the department's 22 comprehensive plan for mental health. These nonprofit 23 corporations shall not be considered agencies of the 24 department or the state of Montana; however, they may retain 25 and enter into retirement programs as established under



Title 19, chapter 3, The Public Employees' Retirement System 1 Act. Upon the establishment of the mental health regions, 2 the county commissioners in each of the various 3 4 participating counties in the region, as defined in subsection (5), shall designate a person from their 5 respective county to serve as a representative of the county 6 on the regional mental health corporation board. The board 7 shall be established under guidelines adopted by the bylaws 8 9 of the corporation. All appointments to the board shall be for terms of 2 years, and the department shall be notified 10 11 in writing of all appointments.

14 (a) annual review and evaluation of mental health15 needs and services within the region;

16 (b) preparation and submission to the department and 17 to each of the counties in the region of plans and budget 18 proposals to provide and support mental health services 19 within the region;

the region in the provision of mental health services within
the limits of this section;

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health services by the participating agencies, including grants from the United States government and other agencies, receipts for established fees for services rendered, tax moneys, gifts, donations, and any other type of support or income. All funds received by the board in accordance with this part shall be used to carry out the purposes of this part.

Funds for each participating county's proportionate share for the operation 25

of mental health services within the region shall be derived from the county's general fund. If the general fund is insufficient to meet the approved budget, a levy not to exceed 1 mill may be made on the taxable valuation of the county in addition to all other taxes allowed by law to be levied on such property.


