Section 1. Bill limit. (1) The legislature by its joint rules shall provide that a legislator may request no more than seven bills prior to and during a regular session of the legislature.

14 (2) A legislator may transfer his authority to request15 a bill to another legislator.

16 Section 2. Applicability. This act applies to joint 17 rules adopted by the 50th legislature and all subsequent 18 legislatures and to bills requested by members of the 51st 19 legislature and all subsequent legislatures.

20 Section 3. Codification instruction. Section 1 is 21 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 5, 22 chapter 4, and the provisions of Title 5, chapter 4, apply 23 to section 1.
