1        (j) illegal drag racing or engaging in a speed  
2 contest in violation of the law, 5 points;

3        (k) operating a motor vehicle without a license to  
4 do so, 2 points (this subsection (k) does not apply to  
5 operating a motor vehicle within a period of 180 days from  
6 the date the license expired);

7        (l) speeding, 3 points;

8        (m) all other moving violations, 2 points. There  
9 shall be no multiple application of cumulative points when  
10 two or more charges are filed involving a single occurrence.  
11 If there are two or more convictions involving a single  
12 occurrence, only the number of points for the specific  
13 conviction carrying the highest points shall be chargeable  
14 against that defendant.

15        (3) "License" means any type of license or permit to  
16 operate a motor vehicle."
