An employee who is requesting reemployment may be certified as vocationally handicapped. An employee who is not employed at the time of application for certification must be certified as vocationally handicapped before entering new employment in order for the new employer to receive the benefits of this part."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any



- existing authority of the division of workers' compensation
- to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act
- is extended to the provisions of this act.
