#### STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

#### Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB152, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill updates the property tax billing process for land owned by the Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks; to continue the tax exempt status of State Park Lands; and providing a retroactive applicability date and an immediate effective date.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The property affected by this proposal will not be assessed by the Property Tax Division.
- 2. The Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks has no basis to calculate the amount of tax exemption provided by the legislation. State Parks are not on tax rolls of local government; without this market value, the amount of tax exempted cannot be calculated.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Passage of this bill maintains the tax exempt status of State Park Lands, and consequently would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks. Failure to pass this bill will result in an annual in lieu of tax liability for the State Park system for an undeterminable amount.

#### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUE OR EXPENDITURES:

Passage of the bill will maintain the tax exempt status of State Parks. Consequently, the proposed legislation will not impact local government revenues as compared to previous fiscal years. The bill may reduce some paperwork flow in County Treasurers' offices and may accelerate county receipt of state payments in lieu of taxes.
