Section 1. Section 61-10-206, MCA, is amended to read: 10 "61-10-206. Special fees -- certain farm vehicles. (1) 11 Except for motortrucks owned and operated by cooperative 12 associations or cooperative marketing associations 13 and subject to the provisions of subsection (2), there shall be 14 paid and collected annually a fee equal to 16% of the fees 15 provided in Schedule I and Schedule II above on motortrucks, 16 trailers, and semitrailers owned and operated by ranchers or 17 farmers in the transportation of their own ranch, farm, 18 orchard, or dairy products from point of production to 19 market, or of supplies, commodities, or equipment to be used 20 on the ranch, farm, orchard, or dairy, or in the infrequent 21 or seasonal transportation by one farmer for another for any 22 purpose other than commercial hire of products of the farm, 23 orchard, it dairy, or of supplies or commodities to be used 24 on the farm, orchard, or dairy, and on one truck tractor and 25

lowboy trailer used by contractors engaged exclusively in 1 soil conservation work and land leveling activities that 2 result in direct benefit to agriculture. However, the 3 minimum fee so paid shall be \$6. The terms "trailers and 4 semitrailers" as used herein shall not include farm wagons. 5 6 (2) The department may not accept a fee under subsection (1) from an owner or operator who has been 7 convicted three times of or who has forfeited bond three 8 times on a violation under 61-10-232 of operating a farm 9 10 truck for commercial hire after payment of the fee under 11 subsection (1)." 12 Section 2. Section 61-10-232, MCA, is amended to read: 13 "61-10-232. Violation -- penalty. Any owner or 14 operator of a motortruck, truck tractor, trailer, semitrailer, bus, or automobile who violates any provision 15 of this part is quilty of a misdemeanor and shall be 16 punished by a fine of not more than \$300 or by a sentence of 17 not more than 60 days in the county jail or both and, when 18 applicable, the prohibition in 61-10-206(2)." 19 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Extension of authority. Any 20 existing authority of the department of highways to make 21 rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is 22 23 extended to the provisions of this act. -End-
