#### STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

#### Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB183, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill would authorize the Fish and Game Commission to create management purpose hunting licenses, and allows the Department to set the price not to exceed the regular fee provided by law for this class of license.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. Existing law allows management purpose hunting licenses for half the price of a regular license. This price could be adjusted to meet the circumstances of hand.
- 2. In some cases, license prices would be reduced lower than half price to attract more hunters to obtain the needed harvest. This would lower Department revenues. However, lower prices should increase license sales. It is estimated that the two will net resulting in no change in Department revenues.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Based on the above assumptions, there is no fiscal impact on the Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks.
