 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12                    Section 1. Section 53-4-113, MCA, is amended to read:

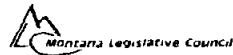
13                    "53-4-113. Child rehabilitation -- duties of  
 14 department. The department shall:

15                    (1) enforce all laws pertaining to children and take  
 16 the initiative in all matters involving the interest of  
 17 ~~illegitimate~~ abused, dependent, and neglected, ~~and~~  
 18 ~~delinquent children where--adequate-provision-therefor-has~~  
 19 ~~not-been-made-by-law;~~

20                    (2) ~~use funds available-for-cases-where~~ allocated or  
 21 appropriated to the department for the purpose of providing  
 22 for the special medical or material assistance-is--necessary  
 23 ~~to--rehabilitate-subnormal~~ needs of developmentally disabled  
 24 or physically handicapped children and--where--it--is--not  
 25 ~~otherwise---provided---for---by---law~~ who are eligible for

1 department programs;  
 2                    (3) cooperate for the purposes hereof with all  
 3 reputable child-helping and child-placing agencies; and  
 4                    (4) inspect, and license,--and--supervise public and  
 5 private infants,--homes--and--child-caring--and youth care  
 6 facilities, child-placing institutions--and agencies, and  
 7 adoption agencies."
