9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 10 Section 1. Section 87-1-225, MCA, is amended to read:
 11 "87-1-225. Regulation of wild animals damaging
 12 property. ~~Upon the~~ Within 48 hours after receiving a request
 13 or complaint of from any landholder or person in possession
 14 and having charge of any land in the state that wild animals
 15 of the state, protected by the fish and game laws and
 16 regulations, are doing damage to the property or crops
 17 thereon, the department shall investigate and study the
 18 situation with respect to damage and depredation. The
 19 department may then decide to open a special season on the
 20 game or, if the special season method be not feasible, the
 21 department may destroy the animals causing the damage. The
 22 department may authorize and grant the holders of said
 23 property permission to kill or destroy a specified number of
 24 the animals causing the damage. No wild ferocious animal
 25 damaging property or endangering life shall be covered by

1 this section."
 2 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any
 3 existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and
 4 parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this
 5 act is extended to the provisions of this act.

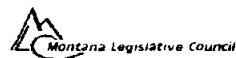
